Position Summary

The Associate Director of VoxYouth's mission is to see middle and high school students grow their faith, discover and develop their gifts, and find their truest identity in Christ through worship, community and service.

Ephesians 4:12 - Their responsibility is to equip God's people to do his work and build up the church, the body of Christ.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Essential functions include, but are not limited to the following:

VoxYouth Ministry Execution Central

- 1. Partner with Central Student Pastor to pilot ongoing new initiatives in programming, structure, branding, outreach, and team discipleship
- 2. Participate in ongoing Local Director meetings for spiritual, leadership, personal, and professional development
- 3. Help organize, recruit, and participate in Central VoxYouth events (i.e. Fall & Winter retreats, Worship Nights, Christmas events, Summer mission trip etc.)
- 4. Participate in VoxYouth Directional Team meetings, Leader Trainings, and in the recruitment and on-boarding of new youth leaders
- 5. Work with the Student Pastor to create content for VoxYouth teaching series
- 6. Maintain database and keep website current with all events and details for all Youth House locations
- 7. Maintain current records and databases for volunteer connections, contact information, background checks, and rosters

Regional

- 1. Manage regional expenses through local budgets
- 2. Work with local directors to ensure they are fully supported to lead their YouthHouse gathering

Local

- 1. Serve as Local Director for one campus in region.
- 2. Participate in weekly (bi-weekly) communication of God's Word as needed at youth gatherings
- 3. Recruit and develop a team of leaders to serve at their YouthHouse location
- 4. Participate in their campus's Directional Team meetings
