Vision New England's (VNE) mission is *accelerating evangelism to transform New England*. For 140 years, we have served God's Church in New England alongside leaders such as Joni Eareckson Tada, Billy Graham, Dr. Michael Haynes, Gordon MacDonald, Dwight Moody, Luis Palau, and many others. Our strategy to *accelerate evangelism* is to *help the Church work in unity to make disciples, do justice and share Jesus*. We believe when followers of Jesus work in unity as Jesus prayed (Jn 17), at the mission He gave us (Mt 28), fixing what's broken and missing in our communities so "people may see our good works and glorify our Father in heaven" (Mt 5), then people care what we have to say about Jesus ... and it transforms lives and New England!

This person will build and support twenty new regional networks, leveraging our experience doing this in multiple regions today.

- Support church efforts to engage their communities with the gospel
- Support prayer efforts and collaboration to reach communities

Communication & Coordination

- Maintain regular communication with ministry partners in each region
- Share stories, progress, needs, activity, and opportunities with the broader VNE network

- Passionate about unity, disciple making, justice, and evangelism in the Body of Christ
- Committed to a robust spiritual life that enables success and sustainability in ministry
- Warm, credible, and able to build trust quickly with diverse leaders
- Humility to serve churches and leaders rather than lead them
- Strong relationship building capabilities, instincts, and emotional intelligence
- High say-do ratio—reliable, consistent, and transparent
- Able to see the big picture while managing details and follow-through
- Proven track record of successfully developing things from scratch, solving problems, spotting opportunities, facilitating and convening leaders, and coordinating initiatives
- Experience working in New England and serving in a church context as staff or a volunteer
